SEXUAL PERVERSIONS

DEFINITION

Sexual perversions are unnatural/perverted/habitual sexual acts aimed to obtain sexual gratification without sexual intercourse.

SEXUAL PERVERT

A person who indulges in such acts is known as a sexual pervert or deviate.

UNNATURAL SEXUAL OFFENCES

Sexual intercourse against the order of nature.



Sodomy Buccal coitus Tribadism (lesbianism/female homosexuality) Bestiality

SADISM

Sexual pleasure from acts of cruelty upon partner, usually of opposite sex.

Sexual perversion in which the infliction of pain is a necessary and sometimes the sole factor for sexual gratification.

• The term is derived from the name of a frenchman, Marquis de Sade (1740-1814) who wrote books in which the characters enjoyed being cruel

• This perversion is more common in males

 The sadist bites, flogs, injures or ill-treats the partner

 Injuries may be inflicted on any body area but breasts and external genitalia are commonly selected In extreme cases, there is a frenzy to commit a violent act, known as lust murder(psychological equivalent of coitus) • The saddist may perform intercourse on the dying or dead victim(necrophilia) • He may tear out the genitals or other organs and drink the blood or eat such flesh to satisfy the sexual desire(necrophagia) • A repeat murder may b committed when the frenzy returns

MASOCHISM

Sexual pleasure from pain or injury received at the hands of partner, usually of opposite sex.

 This is reverse of sadism
 It is more common among males
 Victims of this sexual perversion obtain sexual enjoyment only when they receive a painful stimulus from women

 Such painful stimulus may entirely replace the ordinary sex stimulus

 The term masochism is derived from the name of an Austrian novelist Leopard Sacher Masoch (1836-1895) who described such characters suffering from this perversion Rarely accidental hanging may occur in a masochist during his masochistic exercises (autoerotic deaths)

BONDAGE

Generally, sadism and masochism are found together with one type dominant over the other. The combination is known as Bondage. FETICHISM

Transfer of object of sexuality from human to belongings of the opposite sex.

This is a perversion in which sexual gratification is associated with contact and sight of certain parts of the female body,or even clothing,or articles known as fetish objects.

A fetish object is an object which attracts a person with irrational fascination amouting to magical attraction. Thus clothing, kerchief or shoes of a woman act as a sexual stimulus to a fetishist. The variety of fetish objects is almost limitless. A fetishist who is fascinated by female hair may follow females with long hair and resort to cutting them.

Fetishist; Victim of Fetichism/fetishism:

A fetishist would want to have these objects for sexual gratification and may masturbate in them. This may lead the fetishist to steal such objects or follow women having such objects and he may be often charged with theft or offences against public decency.

EXHIBITIONISM

Sexual pleasure obtained by exposing sex organs to members of the opposite sex.

 The term applies to acts of men whose sexual desire consists principally of the exhibition of genitals with or without performance of masturbatory acts in the presence of women and young girls
 Occasionally, women may expose themselves in public

 It is an obscene act punishable under section 294 IPC

TRANSVESTISM

Sexual gratification obtained by wearing the dress of the opposite sex.

The personality is dominated by the desire to be identified as the opposite sex.

The fantasy being indulged in is clearly being a woman if male & being a man if female.

It is also known as eonism, after the name of a Frenchman Chevalier d'Eon de Beumont who practised this perversion. Transvestite males find sexual pleasure in wearing female garments (trans=across; vest=dress)

 The clothes worn are usually underclothes, brassier, knickers, etc; of an expensive or alluring type

 This perversion is sometimes found in females who dress themselves in male attire

 It is closely associated with masochism and autoerotic hanging (sexual asphyxia)

TRANSSEXUALISM

Desire to adopt the opposite sex.

URANISM

Perversion of sexual instincts including sexual gratification by fingering, fondling, fellatio, cunnilingus.

This perversion is far more common than generally thought of.

Fingering ; manner or technique of using the fingers
 Fondling ; to treat or handle with tenderness or in a loving manner; to caress
 Fellatio ; oral stimulation of penis by male or female
 Cunnilingus ; oral stimulation of female genitals

VOYEURISM

Sexual gratification obtained by looking at naked members of the opposite sex.

Scoptophila

 The desire to observe the genitals of others or to watch sexual intercourse becomes the condition of erotic excitement and gratification

- Voyeurs venture out frequently into parks and nudist camps
- They peer into lighted bedrooms at night (peeping toms)

 They often get themselves into social difficulties and become object of criminal proceedings

FROTTEURISM

Compulsion to rub the genitalia against another person.

Usually experienced in lifts and crowds
It is often accompanied by other perversions.

UROLAGNIA

Sexual excitement provoked by the sight or odor of urine or faeces.

Coprophilia

The pervert may be compelled to smear his partner's body with faeces before attempting intercourse.

PEDOPHILIA

Sexual love directed towards prepubescent children.

HOMOSEXUALITY

Sexual gratification through stimulation by willing partners of the same sex.

LESBIANISM

Sexual gratification among females through mutual stimulation.

BESTIALITY

Sexual intercourse by human being with a lower animal, either through the anus or the vagina.
