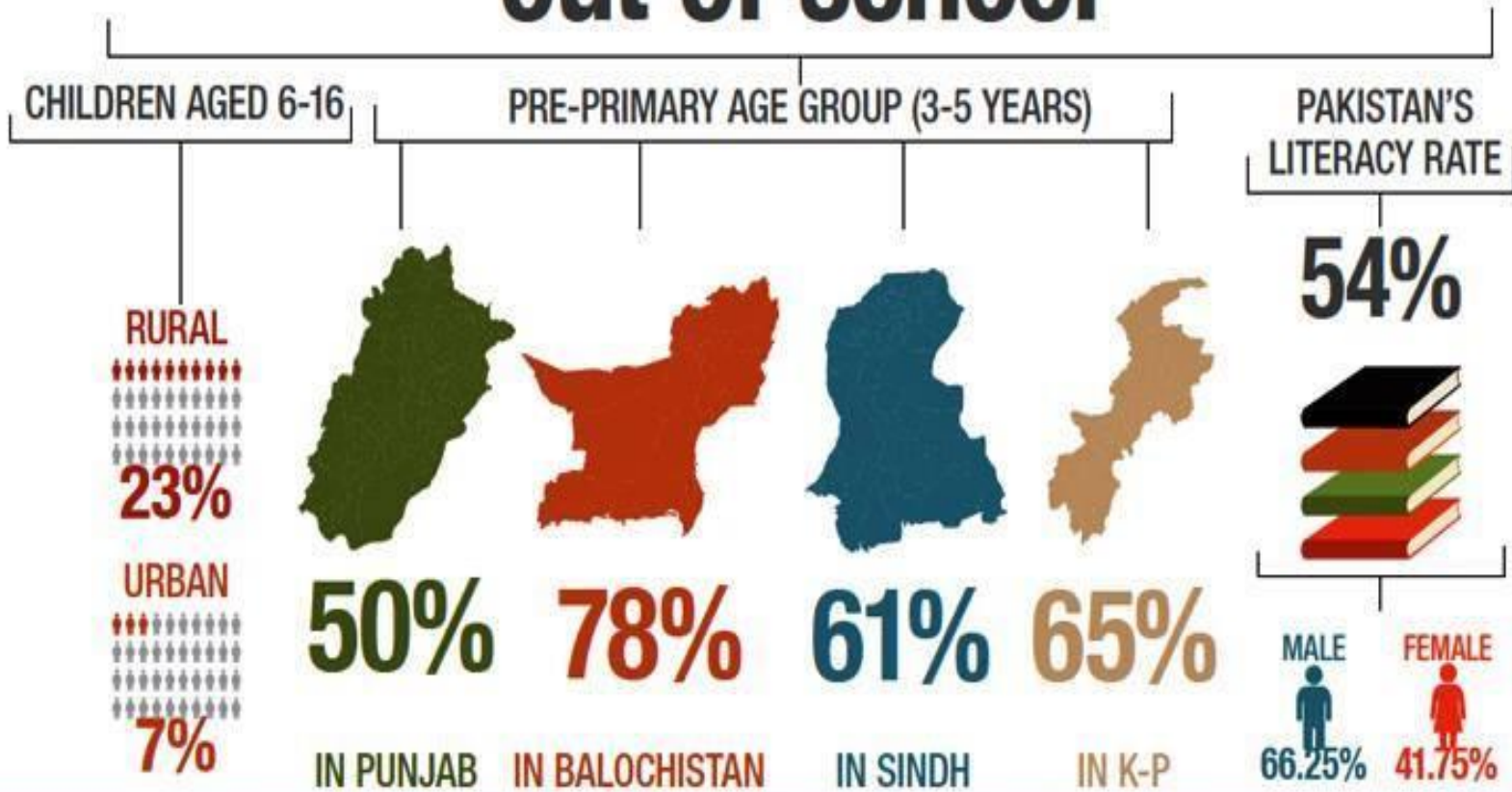
Definition

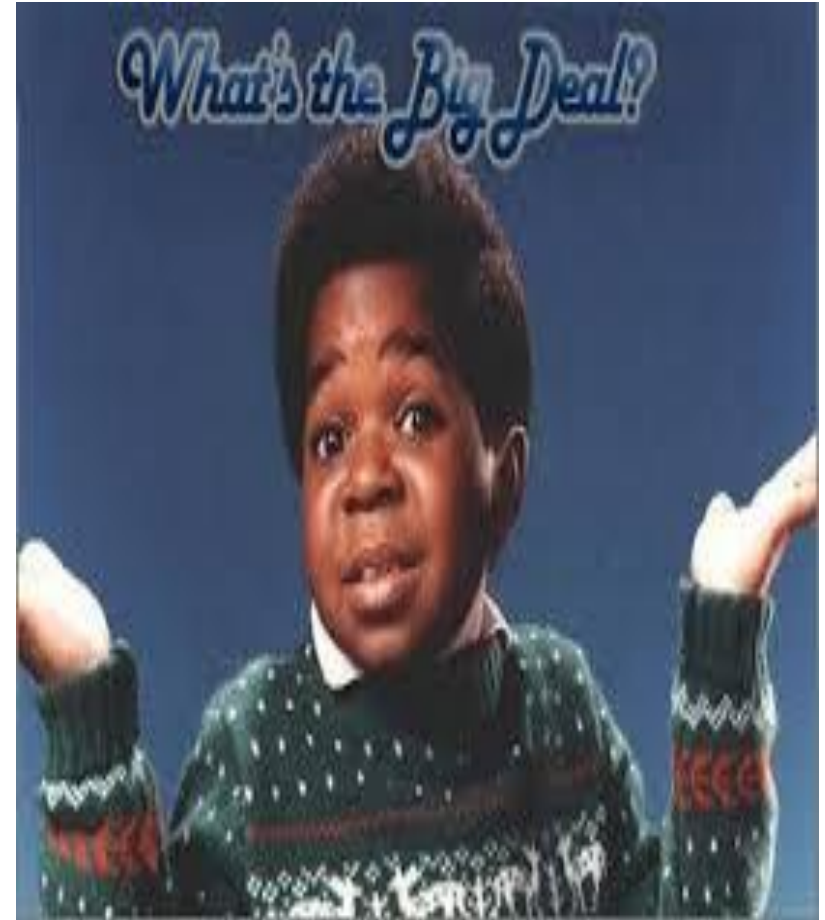
