These are essential & may be needed for future research

Maximum score 5

Chief complaints (CC) in chronological order

These should be those problems which has completed someone to consult the health care worker, Should not be more than 3-4. If many , if there many chief complaints these should be grouped into Active issues & non active issues.

Maximum score 5

History of present illness, it should be a detailed description of the CC keeping in view the differential diagnosis of the CC

For example if someone presents with shortness of breathe one should ask its duration, relation with activities, grading NYHA score, associated cough, wheeze, sputum, hemoptysis, chest pain, leg swelling, Orthopnea, Paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnea, any features of hyperventilation syndrome, seasonal variation

Maximum score 15

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Past medical/surgical history

A detailed description of medical & surgical history as past medical surgical or medical intervention may be the cause of the current problems. For instance previous ileal resection for enteric perforation may be the reason of megaloblastic anemia (B 12 deficiency)

Maximum score 5

Drugs history

A detailed account of present medication, previous medications & any documented drugs allergies

Maximum score 5

Family history

It should be a detailed account of brothers, sisters, parents, cousins

Maximum score 2

Personnel history

It should be a detailed account of his job, present, past, travels, addiction, walk, exercise, diet

Maximum score 2

Systemic enquiry

It should include detailed direct questions related to CVS, CNS, GIT, MSK, Endocrine, hematology, dermatology, genitourinary system. The detailed direct question can be found in Clinical methods by [Nicolas Talley](#).

Maximum score 6

General Physical examination

A detailed account of general survey, first the vitals such as pulse, BP, Temperature, SPO2, skin color, jaundice, edema, JVP, nails, skin rash, lymph nodes & a detailed description, posture

Maximum score 5

The system which you think to be the cause of the chief complaints

That system should be examined a greater detail which you think is involved based on the history so far obtained. There should not be NAD written in any systemic examination as for students it means "Not Actually Done".

Maximum score 5

Cardiovascular system

A detailed account of Pulse including rate rhythm, character, volume, synchrony & radio femoral delay, BP lying standing, JVP height, waves, types of waves, Precordium examination, apex beat, any thrills, S1, S2, murmurs radiation or extra sounds like rub etc.

Maximum score 5

Respiratory system

A detailed description of respiratory rate, type, examination of chest, inspection, palpation (trachea, chest movements, expansion ,tenderness, rub), percussion, auscultation of breathe sounds, extra sounds etc.

GIT

A detailed account of oro dental hygiene, Inspection of abdomen from foot end, palpation, percussion, auscultation

Maximum score 5

CNS

A detailed account of mini mental score, consciousness, speech, cranial nerves, sensory system, motors system, cerebellar signs, gait & spine.

Maximum score 5

Musculoskeletal system

A detailed description of joints, bones, deformities etc.

Maximum score 5

Endocrine

A detailed description of thyroid, hairs, private parts, primary & secondary sex characters etc.

Maximum score 5

Dermatological examination

A detailed examination of the skin & mucous membranes for rash etc. & its complete description even if it is normal.

Maximum score 5

Differential diagnosis

Reasonable DD which are relevant to history & physical examination

All investigations & take a photograph from ECG, scan & ECG & past it at appropriate place.
